As part of my visit today, I would like to have a sexual health check including the following tests recommended for me by the *Australian Sexually Transmitted Infection & HIV Testing Guidelines 2014 for Asymptomatic Men Who Have Sex with Men*.

Site specimen test	STI	Comment
Pharyngeal swab PCR/ NAAT	Chlamydia & gonorrhoea	Self-collected or clinician-collected
Anorectal swab PCR/ NAAT	Chlamydia & gonorrhoea	Self-collected or clinician-collected
First void urine PCR/ NAAT	Chlamydia	Alternative: self-collected or clinician-collected penile meatal swab
Serology	Syphilis	
	HIV	If HIV negative
	Hepatitis A	Test if not vaccinated. Vaccinate if antibody negative
	Hepatitis B Core antibody and surface antibody	Test if not vaccinated. Vaccinate if no history or documentation of full vaccination course
	Hepatitis C	Only in HIV-positive or if history of injecting drug use
