


MEDICARE LOCALS are primary health care organisations recently established to coordinate primary **health care delivery** and tackle local health care needs and service gaps.

WHAT YOU CAN DO – INITIAL CONTACT – MEDICARE LOCALS:

- Contact the CEO of Medicare Local to discuss local needs and local clinical and health promotion services
- Present local STI/BBV data to Medicare Local CEO or Board use 'NSW Medicare Local Planning Project' documents on ASHM website to highlight:
 - Disease prevalence in the area
 - Low rates of STI testing
- Discuss GP and PN role in responding to STI testing, treatment, contact tracing
- Invite Medicare Local board members and staff to visit and tour the Publically Funded Sexual Health Service (PFSHS)
- Discuss the support that can be provided by your service to GPs,
 PNs and the Medicare Local

ESTABLISHING A RELATIONSHIP WITH MEDICARE LOCALS:

Medicare Locals (ML) are an essential communication network and vital for promoting education opportunities to general practice.

- Develop a Sexual Health Special Interest Group, co chaired by ML and LHD, with stakeholders like PFSHS, HARP HP, ACCHOs, NGOs, education providers, GPs and PN with relevant interest or experience
- Develop a GP Sexual Health Project Advisory or Working Group to develop a project to promote sexual health within the general practice setting
- Present sexual health updates to Medicare Local staff and discuss the role of general practice
- Inform the Medicare Local of funding opportunities, like
 World AIDS Day, and work with them to develop a local project
- Deliver Sexual Health Education for GPs (STI ALM available through ASHM NSW)
- Distribute sexual health resources, information and newsletters to GPs and PNs via Medicare Local networks
- Write a regular article for the Medicare Locals Newsletter
- Work with the Medicare Local to develop referral pathways to local services
- Consider joint projects with the Medicare Local and the Youth services
- Utilise the STIPU proforma's to support GPs to undertake RACGP activities in sexual health www.stipu.nsw.gov.au
